Example Skills:

- Vowel sounds (e.g., "Find all of the short *a* words you can.")
- Spelling patterns (words with *bl*_, *tr*_, *_ow*, *_tion*, etc.)
- Parts of speech (nouns, verbs, adjectives, etc.)
- Word families (e.g., "Find all of the *_ake* words you can.")

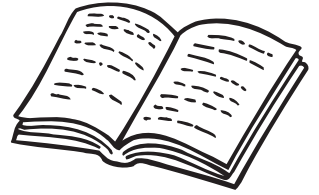
