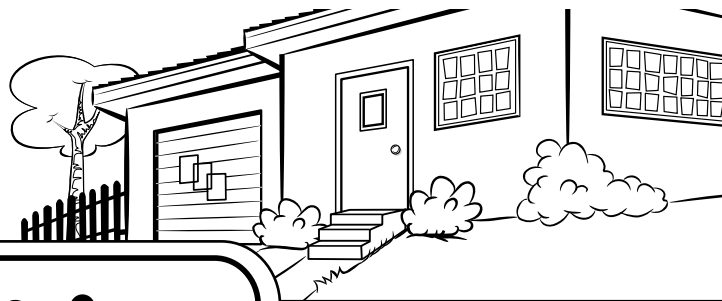


# NEIGHBORHOOD JOBS MATH
