#### Making a Travel Journal Is Easy

Since making a journal requires the use of a stapler, we recommend adult supervision.

- After printing them out, stack the full-page sheets faceup in the following order from top to bottom:
  - 1 back cover/cover 2 pages 17-2 3 pages 15-4 4 pages 13-6 5 pages 11-8
- Then, carefully fold the entire stack in half and make a crease.
- Keeping the pages together, unfold the stack and staple three staples along the length of the crease to make a spine. Be sure to staple through the top of the stack so that the tips of the staples are on the inside of the journal.
- Now, you're ready to draw and write about your trip. Just follow the prompts! (To keep the color from bleeding through the pages, we suggest using crayons.)
